Miracle #23 – Jesus Heals a Deaf and Dumb Man

Mark 7:31-37

- **Mark 7:31-32**

Mark is the only gospel which records this miracle. The coast of Decapolis was a very important region of the teaching and healing ministries of Jesus.

Significant in the recording of this miracle is the word "They." Unnamed persons played a huge role in this miracle account.

1. "They bring unto Him" (Verse 32)
2. "They should tell no man" (Verse 36)
3. "They were beyond measure astonished"(Verse 37)

The un-named persons connect with the "whosoever" of Christian salvation.

They brought a man who could neither hear nor speak and asked Jesus to lay a healing hand on him. It is now evident that the people believed.

- **Mark 7:33-35**

This is one of only two times that Jesus took someone aside for private healing.

- **Mark 8:23**

These are instances where Jesus desires to have personal contact with those whom He heals. He touches them in a personal way.

Jesus touched the man, looked up to heaven and said "Ephphatha."

- **Mark 7:36-37**

Jesus had told the people who crowded around to tell no one, but they proclaimed it widely. Even after they had time to consider what had happened they were overwhelmed. They were astonished. They made Jesus known to all with whom they came in contact.
